**Howell High School** is one of 50 school buildings in Michigan randomly selected by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to participate in the 2025 Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS). The YRBS provides essential state data on the health behaviors of high school students that place students at increased risk for illness, disability, and death. The YRBS data allow Michigan districts to leverage federal dollars and provide benchmarks for local survey efforts such as the Michigan Profile for Healthy Youth (MiPHY). Each school's participation is crucial to ensure continued representative results that have been established since 1997.

The information generated from this project will be used by numerous education and health agencies to plan and implement effective programs and allocate resources that will affect student learning and achievement. Your school's data will be combined with those from all others surveyed to generate statewide results. Participating districts, buildings, and students will not be identified.

In the coming weeks, Nicole Kramer from the Michigan Department of Education will work with the school's contact person to randomly select approximately four to six classrooms within the building to complete the survey.
